Training Services Agreement

I / We (print handler's name) _____ have voluntarily employed J-Canine Pet Resort to assist me in the training of my dog (print dog's name) _____.

I understand that the instructors contracted by J-Canine Pet Resort will work with me and my pet to impart contemporary animal behavior knowledge that best fits our needs and that successful companion pet programs depend on a combination of learned skills on the part of the pet and owner.

Behavior is not static; an animal will not continue to perform even trained behaviors without ongoing practice. I understand that the effectiveness of completed training program depends upon many factors over which the trainer has no control. Such factors include, but are not limited to, the future health of the dog, the frequency and effectiveness of training practice and correct reinforcement which the owner must learn and give the dog. Especially in cases involving any type of aggression, although behavior may be modified, the dog is never considered "cured." A pet's behavior is ultimately the owner's responsibility. The trainer will make every reasonable effort to help us attain our goals but makes no guarantees of performance on the part of us (the owner) or our pet as a result of providing professional animal behavior instruction & consultation.

I acknowledge that agility training, obedience training / behavior modification may be an activity in which damage of injury to dog and / or person may occur. Owner will assume full financial / moral responsibility for the actions of their dog. I further acknowledge that dogs may be exposed to a variety of environmental conditions which include, but are not limited to, vehicular travel, interaction with people and other animals, exposure to adverse weather and exposure to areas with crowds, and all types of traffic.

I agree that I, my heirs, assignees and legal representatives will not make claim against, sue, or attach the property of Trainer, her family, acquaintances, or any other person acting on her behalf, for injury or damage to myself or my dog, or any other persons accompanying me to training during the course of this training. I forever release Trainer and her agents from any and all liability and demands and assume all risks myself.

This contract for training services supercedes all other agreements written or oral, previously made between myself and Trainer.

- **Handlers will be responsible for keeping their pet on leash whenever instructed by the Trainer.**
- **Handlers will come prepared for class wearing appropriate footwear (shoes with traction to wear on outdoor turf; no sandals, flip-flops, or shoes with heels).**
- **Handler will provide or purchase soft treats to use in class. Snack treat baggies are sold in the lobby at JCPR.**
- **We teach you how to train your dog – we do not train your dog for you in group classes.**
- **You are responsible for your own dog while you and your dog are on JCPR's premises and its surroundings. This includes, but is not limited to, monitoring your dog, prohibiting your dog from approaching other dogs, bothering other dogs or becoming aggressive with other dogs or people. Handlers observed using harsh corrections will be excused from class.**
- **You are responsible for keeping your dog up to date on vaccinations and free of parasites, fleas, and ticks.**
- **You must clean up after your dog with the sanitary scoops/disinfectant provided and dispose of all trash appropriately.**
- **A six-foot leash and either a flat buckle collar or martingale are suggested for class. No bark, or shock collars or harnesses will be permitted in class. Head halters are allowable with consent of the instructor.**
- **In the event classes must be cancelled participants will be called with the phone number we have on file to give notification as soon as possible.**
- **Tuition is required to hold your class reservation. In the event class is postponed, we will hold your tuition deposit to be applied to a future class. JCPR does not allow aggressive or vicious dogs in group classes. Dogs who are potentially dangerous to other dogs, handlers, or the instructor will be dismissed from class, and referred to a behavior modification program, if requested by the owner. In the case of dismissal, NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN, and the dismissed dog may not enroll in group classes at JCPR for the safety of its participants and for the good of the student dog exhibiting over-threshold behaviors.**

I understand and agree to these aforementioned terms and conditions contained here and agree to comply with the rules, regulations and information provided by JCPR and its instructors.
